


Yusif Vazir Chamanzaminli, Essad Bey (Lev Nussimbaum), Grigol Robakidze or Elfriede Ehrenfels? No doubt, "The Business of Literature" was, and is, still part of the puzzle today, now that the novel is available in 33 languages.




Yusif Vazir Chamanzaminli

Lev Nussimbaum - Essad Bev "The Lives of Two Writers" Yusif Vazir Chamanzaminli (1887-1943) and Lev Nussimbaum / Essad Bey (1905-1942)

Essad Bev fled Baku when the Bolsheviks took control in 1920: Chamanzaminli, who was out of the country on a diplomatic mission, decided to risk returning to be with his people. He was given permission to return but soon was charged as a counter-revolutionary writer and sentenced to the GULAG where he died.

Sketches and doodles in a student





Essad Bey's secret "memoir-cum-noveldiary" called Der Mann (The Man Who Knew Nothing About Love), which he signed as Kurban Said was never published. But it has been found and the transcript fully published all six notebooks—in German, thanks to Professor Wilfried Fuhrmann. Frequently Asked Questions, FAQ 153.

Essad Bey wrote that cheating wives (implying his own wife Erika) should be tied up in a sack with a wild cat and thrown into the Bosphorus. The sensitive love story Ali & Nino was published during the same period. Same core author? Same Kurban Said?....
